Street Pastors is all about making our streets better, safer places to be, protecting the vulnerable and being a listening ear for those that need to talk. We rely on voluntary donations to keep our valuable work going, and to keep growing. We are now urgently seeking 100 people who would be prepared to commit to giving £10 per month via standing order to support Street Pastors on the Island's streets. If we can achieve our target of 100 supporters then we can pay for the ongoing management, training, support and supplies for over 30 Street Pastors – enough to put teams on the streets of two Island towns one night per week. What's more we can use your donations to help draw in match funding and make an even greater impact on the Islands streets.

ABOUT STREET PASTORS

Street Pastors is a cross-church response to urban problems, engaging with people on the streets to care, listen and dialogue. Street Pastors are volunteers from local churches who go out on the streets between 10pm and 4am, currently in Ryde on a Friday night, though there are plans to expand this to many other areas of the Island. They are not there to preach or force their beliefs on people, but simply to care, to talk, to listen and to offer practical help where they can. This could involve giving out bottles of water, flip-flops or foil blankets, or just sitting and listening to someone.
